# Hpa An

Hpa An is a quaint town located in Kayin State in Southern Myanmar. Situated quite close to Yangon, Hpa An is a picturesque riverside town surrounded by dramatic limestone karst mountains. The town has a laid-back feel, surrounded by the stunning scenic beauty that lets travellers relax and get away from the hustle and bustle of city life.

## DAY TRIPS FROM HPA AN

» You can go for day trips to see the **golden rock** at **Kyaiktiyo Pagoda** and **the country's largest reclining Buddha** at **Mawlamyine**. Bus services are available to these sites. You can also hire taxis.

## GETTING THERE

- » **By Bus:** Daily bus services are available from Yangon, Kyaiktiyo Pagoda, Mawlamyine and Thaton to Hpa An.
- » **By Ferry:** Government-run ferry services are available from Mawlamyine to Hpa An.

## GETTING AROUND

- » **Tuk-tuks:** The best way to get around. Readily available from the centre of town.  
Cost: 19,500 Kyats per day  
Capacity: 6 people
- » **Motorbike:** Available for hire from shops in the market.  
Cost: 9,000 Kyats per day



### KYAUT KA LATT PAGODA

- » A stunning Buddhist monument perched precariously on the top of a **stone island** in the **middle of a lake**.

### SADAN CAVE

- » One of the **principal caves** in Hpa An. It is a **gigantic cave** with impressive stalactite and stalagmite structures.

### PICTURESQUE SUNSETS

- » There's a small terrace near a golden pagoda that offers a splendid view of the scenic sunset. You can also visit **Than Lwin Bridge** to enjoy the picturesque sunset behind the stunning limestone rocks.

### LUMBINI BUDDHA GARDEN

- » A beautiful garden with hundreds of statues of Buddha. The garden is **well-maintained** with the landscaping of flowering trees.

### WALK AROUND

- » Hpa An is **best enjoyed on foot**. Being a small town, you will get the best of your visit by walking around.

### BIKING

- » A great way to enjoy this cute town. You can simply rent a bicycle and set out on your own or opt for a guided tour.

### HIKE UP MT. ZWE KA BIN

- » The **trek up** Mount Zwe Ka Bin **takes 2 to 3 hours**. You will pass through a Buddha forest. The view from the top is worth the effort.



- » Hpa An has a **bustling local market**. You can get fresh produce here. You can also pick up magnificent **local handmade fabric products**.



- » The eateries of Hpa An offer delicious local delicacies. There are shops that sell **homemade ice creams** and **milkshakes**. Try the **local sweets, curries** and **noodle soups** available in town. Don't miss the **rice vermicelli, fried dumplings** and **fresh fruit juices** served in the shops here.



## ACCOMMODATION

Hpa An has a range of accommodation options. You can find clean and comfortable rooms at your desired budget. Rooms can be rented for as low as **15,000 Kyats** per night.
