## WHERE NATURE RESIDES

Indawgyi Lake is the largest inland lake of Southeast Asia, located in the Mohnyin Township in the Kachin State of Myanmar. This lake is the ideal destination for backpackers and nature lovers seeking a peaceful holiday. There are approximately 20 villages around the lake, predominantly inhabited by the Shan and Kachin ethnic groups. The lake is also home to the Indawgyi Lake Wildlife Sanctuary, a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve.





## **SHWE MITZU PAGODA**

A beautiful pagoda located on the water, which casts a beautiful reflection on the lake in the late afternoon sunlight.

# SHWE TAUNG (GOLDEN MOUNTAIN)

>> Located on the northern shore of the lake, this is a hill with a pagoda on top and a great view of the lake.

# LAKESIDE VILLAGES

>> Several villages are located around the lake. The notable ones are Lwemun Village, Hepa and Namme. Namde and Nammilaung villages also have elephants.

#### **KAYAKING**

Enjoy kayaking in the vast lake. It is a good way to visit the villages and Shwe Mitzu Pagoda.

#### **TREKKING**

>> There are several trekking routes that you can explore. They will take you through the wildlife sanctuary.

## **BIRD WATCHING**

This is a bird watcher's paradise. The lake is a major stop for migratory birds in winter.

>> Several local products such as Kachin bags, handmade jewellery, tissue holders and Kachin woven fabric can be found here.

>> Taste delicious dishes at local eateries. From traditional cuisine to international delicacies, restaurants around Indawgyi Lake serve almost everything.



## **BEST TIME TO VISIT:**

October to December offers the best visibility of the lake with no rainfall and a cool temperature. If you are looking to bird-watch, January is the best time to catch the migratory birds. In March, (on the full moon day) you will be able to
