






the same name which is located on a reef about 900 feet (274m) from the sea shore and thus usually called Ye Lel Paya, "pagoda amidst water". The locals usually

And for another, women are only allowed to worship from a pavilion removed from the pagoda while men may do so from the hall facing the main image. There is an annual festival about this pagoda.

**KYAIK MA YAW PAGODA** Located 24km south east of Mawlamyine. The famous of the town is Kyaik Ma Yaw Pagoda. The main Buddha image sits in the position of the legs hanging down as if sitting on a chair. The name Kyaik Ma Yaw stands for Distinctive Image. Kyaikmaraw Pagoda was the temple built by Queen Shin Saw Pu in 1455 in the late Mon regional style. The Pagoda festival is usually held annually during the transition of Myanmar New Year in April. It is accessible via a sealed road. Many Muslim and Hindu communities live along the picturesque road. The temple is also well known for its hundreds of beautiful






**KYAIK THAN LAN PAGODA** KyaikThan Lan Pagoda was erected in 875 A.D during the reign of King Mutpi Raja. A hair relic of the Buddha, Tripitaka manuscripts and gold images of the Buddha were enshrined in the pagoda. In the years that followed, successive kings raised the pagoda higher and higher until it reached a height of 46m from its original height of 17m. The base of the pagoda at present is 137m in circumference and right



No matter how many times, the mole on the Buddha's face is offered with gold foil, it never fades away. The image is always facing



Thanbyuzayat is about 64 km (40 miles) south of Mawlamyine (Moulmein) and 24 kilometres (15 miles) south-east of Kyaikkami (Amherst) and Setse beach.

# SETSE BEACH

Setse is a beach resort on the Gulf of Martaban of the Andaman Sea in Thanbyuzayat Township of Mon State in Southern Myanmar. The beach itself is composed of brown sand, is quite wide and about 5.6 kilometers long, but the water is often muddy when currents bring down silt from the Salween river which enters the Gulf of Martaban just to the north. Setse has been a resort since the 19th century, and still remains popular.



# **KABYAR WA BEACH**

Kabyar Wa, arguably one of the most beautiful beaches in Myanmar, just 25 kilometers from Ye in southern Mon State. For its 13 km (8-mile) length it boasts almost 100



### **THATON**

Thaton is said to be the original capital of the Mons but now that distinction has shifted to Mawlamyaing. However, Thahton still boasts some historical links. There are remnants of an old city wall with the shrine of a Bagan hero, Byatwi, who became a nat(spirit) after being killed by the lord of the town when he fell in love with the governor's beautiful daughter. Now he is regarded as the guardian of the town and people come here to pray.
